We provide small class sizes and personalised support to ensure the needs of every child are consistently met and that every student is able to make progress academically, personally and socially.

We cater for over 200 young people with various special educational needs, including speech and language and communication needs, Autism Spectrum disorders and moderate learning difficulties. Many pupils have a combination of special educational needs and all have an education, health and care plan.

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#### ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Stony Dean School is a heavily oversubscribed secondary special school situated in Amersham in Buckinghamshire. We are very proud of the fact that we were the first school in this county to gain specialist SEN College status and our designation is for Communication and Interaction. This underpins the whole life of the school and our curriculum focuses on language development for all our students.

The students who attend Stony Dean come from across the south of Buckinghamshire and occasionally from neighbouring authorities or from the north of this county, if their specific SEN cannot be met elsewhere.

Our school is a calm and productive learning environment, where the staff team seek to maximise the potential of every student and to take advantage of every learning opportunity. The school is consistently successful in achieving appropriate Post 18 placements for students in either colleges, supported internships or employment with training. Many of these further education places will be on "mainstream" college courses, as our students will have met the entry requirements and will have the self-confidence as independent learners to participate fully in the adult world.

Our beliefs and philosophies of teaching and learning are underpinned by the values of collaborative practice. As a school, our therapists and teachers work together to ensure that students have the best possible educational experience. Strategies and interventions are research based and targeted to support the needs of the students. We believe that every child can succeed and we have tailored our curriculum to develop their literacy, employability and independent living skills.

Stony Dean students are lively, thoughtful and always ready to participate in a wide range of curriculum and extracurricular activities. They are a remarkable group of young people and it is an enormous privilege to work alongside them as they make the journey following the transition from primary school, all the way to adulthood.





### WHAT MAKES OUR SCHOOL DISTINCTIVE?

### **Curriculum Breadth**

The school offers a heavily adapted curriculum, designed to support different groups of learner's successes. Students experience learning in a group setting that target keys areas of their academic and social development. We offer a range of accreditations depending upon the student pathway and future aspirations. Students complete appropriate qualifications for their ability and need in English, Maths and Science as well as a range of other subjects.

The school is rapidly developing its vocational and Learning 4 Life courses and also has positive links with a range of external providers. Work related learning is on the timetable for all students and this is the vehicle we use to enable them to experience the practical application of their learning and to gain the skills necessary to achieve independence. Students within our Sixth Form, complete modules towards their Princes Trust qualifications and also participate in work placements, greatly assisting them to achieve employment after leaving us. Students also take part in lessons that develop their speech and language abilities, both practically and socially, as well as targeted lessons focusing on their individual outcomes of their EHCPs, as they move through the school.

### **Extra-Curricular Activity**

As well as external providers, Stony Dean is fortunate to have dedicated staff who volunteer their time to organise extra-curricular clubs and activities. This year we have clubs at lunchtime and after school offering activities such as football, cooking, table tennis, art, basketball, music, boxing and ICT to name but a few. We also run homework clubs at lunchtime to support students who may struggle to complete homework tasks at home.

Trips are a strength of Stony Dean. Students have the privilege of going out on trips regularly as part of their studies, as well as to encourage and support their social development. Trips include visits to Hazard Alley, the Swan Theatre, Whipsnade Zoo and more local visits to the surrounding towns and villages to get the students used to buying a drink in a coffee shop or purchasing an item from a shop. Students in Years' 11 and above also have the option to attend the annual residential trip, most recently to North Yorkshire and Wales, further developing their independence and life skills.

### Community

The school has excellent links with the local community; both in Amersham itself, and the surrounding area. The school takes part in many local community events such as performing arts at Energize - Wycombe Swan Theatre and links with Amersham Town Council. As a result of our involvement in such events, we are proud to receive numerous awards over the years, including most recently, The Amersham Town Council Community Support and Involvement Award. We also organise a number of events on the school site for the local community and parents. Highlights have included the Christmas and Summer Fayres, Sports Days, Art Shows and Coffee Mornings.

### What do parents say?

Key strengths of the school are seen to be the location/setting, the leadership and management, the safe, secure and welcoming environment and the breadth of opportunities available to children. Parents comment regularly on how pleased they are with their child's progress and how easily they settle in to the school. Because we so often support families in matters beyond their child's education, parents are also positive about how much support they receive from specialists and teachers working in the school. We are often their first port of call in times of need, as well as in times of celebration. We often receive emails with comments such as:

#### What do students say?

The students are very positive about their school. They feel well supported and that their teachers and tutors genuinely care for their well-being and education. Staff forge excellent working relationships with the students at the school and we often discover how important this has been to them when they reach an important transition point, such as the end of Year 11 or 13. Some comments from such students have been:
